Bouvet Island


- Norwegian territory (Bouvetøya)
- Discovered by Jean-Baptiste Charles Bouvet de Lozier on January 1, 1739
- Norwegians were the first to set foot on the island in 1927
- Covered 93% by snow and ice
- Average 300 storms/year; winds reaching often 100 miles/hour
- Volcanic cone shaped Island
- Highest peak: 780m
- Size: half the size of Manhattan
- Norwegian overseas territory, together with Peter 1 Island (3Y/P), Jan Mayen (JX), and Svalbard (JW)
- No humans! Lots of penguins (5k) and fur seals (65k)
